Pupil Premium Funding 2016/17

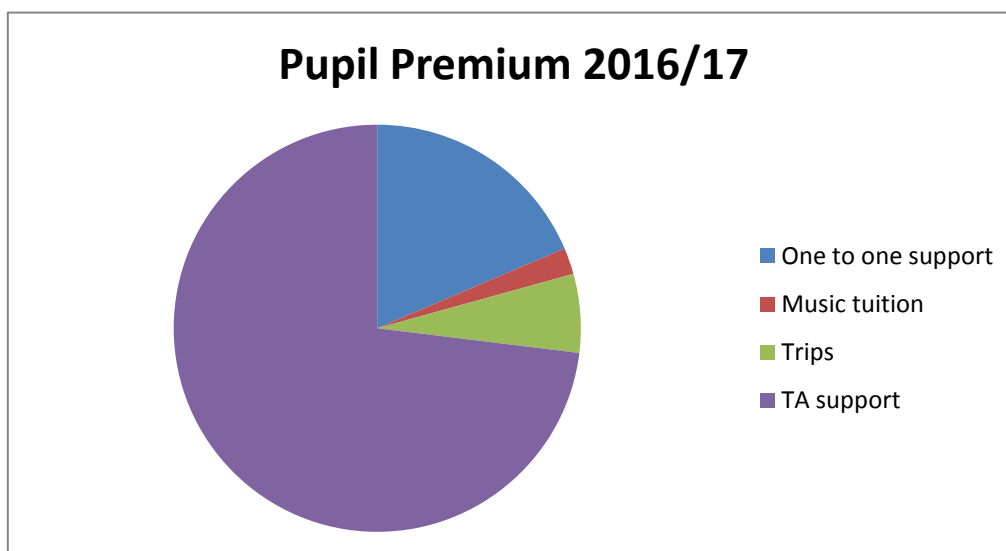
Our school allocation for 2016/17= £11720

Pauntley C of E Primary School is an inclusive school and strives to:

1. Ensure that teaching, learning and opportunities within the school meet the needs of all our pupils.
2. Ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups; this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed.
3. Make provision for socially disadvantaged pupils.
4. Recognise that not all pupils who are eligible for funding will be socially disadvantaged.

How may our pupil premium funding be spent?

- One to one tuition by qualified and experienced staff
- Individual or group TA support for personalised learning
- Purchase of intervention programmes and their associated resources led by TAs
- External professional support including assessments and interventions
- Teacher and TA training and courses
- Purchase of resources to help the learning of pupil entitled to the funding
- Subsidising school trips, swimming tuition, music tuition
- Extra-curricular activities



How has the money been spent?

- £1320 on one to one support
- £4180 on TA support in and out of the classroom
- £528 on funding school trips
- £177.50 on music tuition

What is the impact of pupil premium spending?

- There were four children entitled to PP funding in September 2016.
- One PP child joined the school in December 2016.
- Of the £11720 due to be allocated, £5120 was allocated to children who left the school in July 2016.
- The children are assessed against key objectives for Writing and Maths and complete termly reading assessments.
- Data shows that 4 out of the 5 children are working at age related expectations for all areas.
